APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE TO LAND AT BUCK-  
EYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO—NAT W. MOR-  
ROW, COLUMBUS, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: This is to acknowledge the receipt of a communication under date of June 10, 1936, over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks in the Division of Conservation, enclosing a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to one Nat W. Morrow of Columbus, Ohio. By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$24.00, payable in semiannual installments of \$12.00, each, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes that portion of the inner slope and waterfront and the outer slope and borrow pits in the rear thereof, that is included in the west half of Embankment Lot No. 5, east of the waste gates on the north shore of Buckeye Lake, as laid out by the Ohio Canal Commission in 1905, and being part of the southeast quarter of Section 14, Town 17, Range 18, Licking County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner, acting on behalf of the state of Ohio, and by Nat W. Morrow, the lessee therein named. I further find, upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutes relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form,

as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
