ACTION TAKEN:

I was working car #431 and responded to the Lakeshore Blvd area reference an officer involved shooting incident. The scene was secured by the time I arrived, so I went to Kenmore Blvd/Lakeshore Blvd to assist with securing the area where the incident initially started. Officer Brown #1269 and I assisted members of the Gun Violence Unit with checking for gun casings along Lakeshore Blvd. We didn't discover any casings during our search and later learned the suspect used a revolver. After we stopped searching, I relocated my cruiser to the corner of Lakeshore Blvd/Vincent St to prevent traffic coming from Vincent St onto Lakeshore Blvd. I remained at Lakeshore Blvd/Vincent St until I was cleared to go back in service by Sgt Gupta. During the incident I didn't have my BWC. I had just walked into the Community Relations office when the incident occurred and I didn't have time to retrieve it from the 5th floor BWC room.
