DEAR SIR:—Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of December 29, 1920, with which you transmitted for my examination two separate leases in triplicate form from the state of Ohio to William J. Miller and James Abrams, administrators of the estate of Edward J. Miller, deceased, covering renewals of two leases of lots at Buckeye Lake held by Edward J. Miller at the date of his death.

I note that both of these leases contain provisions to the effect that they are for the sole use and benefit of the estate of Edward J. Miller, deceased, and that the leases are being taken in the names of the lessees by direction of the probate court of Franklin county, Ohio.

While your letter does not state the appraised value of the lands covered by these two leases, I learned by inquiry at your department that the appraisements are respectively \$5,000.00 and \$400.00.

I have carefully examined said leases, find them correct in form and legal, and I am therefore returning them with my approval endorsed thereon.
