APPROVAL—RESERVOIR LAND LEASE, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, WITH JOHN TREADWELL, THORNVILLE, OHIO, TERM FIFTEEN YEARS, ANNUAL RENTAL \$15.00, LOT NO. 1, VILLAGE OF THORNTON, PERRY COUNTY, OHIO, FOR COTTAGE SITE AND LANDING PURPOSES ONLY.

DEAR SIR: You recently submitted for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the State of Ohio through you as Conservation Commissioner to John Treadwell of Thornville, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$15.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the permission to occupy and use for cottage site and landing purposes only, that portion of Lot No. 1 in the Village of Thornton, Perry County, Ohio, that is included in the portion filled by the State dredge at the southeast corner of said lot, and containing 2574 square feet, more or less, and being part of Section 4, Town 18, Range 17, Perry County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.
