**Narrative:**

On Thursday, March 7, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Eric Lehnhart (SA Lehnhart) received Thomas Nock's (Nock) emergency medical services (EMS) response records from the North Olmsted Fire Department. SA Lehnhart reviewed the EMS records and noted the following:

Nock's EMS records consisted of five (5) pages.

North Olmsted Fire Department (NOFD) Medic 52 responded to [REDACTED] North Olmsted, Ohio 44070, for a gunshot wound (GSW) victim. Upon their arrival they discovered that the original GSW victim had been transported to University Hospitals: St. John Medical Center by police. A second GSW victim was located a few residences down at 5219 Berkshire Drive, North Olmsted, Ohio 44070. At this location, a male patient, approximately thirty (30) years of age, presented unresponsive lying supine on the ground with cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) already initiated by the police. The patient's treatment was transferred to Cleveland Clinic: Fairview Hospital trauma staff for continued trauma care.
