APPROVAL—LEASE TO RESERVOIR LAND AT BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO—ENID M. MARGUARDT, DAYTON, OHIO.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, September 24, 1936.

Hon. Earl H. Hanefeld, Director, Department of Agriculture, Columbus. Ohio.

DEAR SIR: I am in receipt of a communication from the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, with which was submitted for my approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Enid M. Marquardt of Dayton, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years and which provides for an annual rental of \$24.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site, docklanding and boathouse purposes, only, that portion of the State Reservoir land included in Lot No. 20, of the reallotment of Minnewauken Island in Indian Lake; said island being in Virginia Military Survey No. 12276, Stokes Township, Logan County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
