These bonds comprise part of two issues of bonds of the above village dated December 20, 1931, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, one being waterworks improvement special assessment bonds in the aggregate amount of \$24,000 and the other being waterworks improvement village portion bonds in the aggregate amount of \$7,100.

From this examination, in the light of the law under authority of which these bonds have been authorized, I am of the opinion that bonds issued under these proceedings constitute a valid and legal obligation of said village.
