You have submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names, containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution of the State of Ohio by adding to Article VIII thereof thirteen (13) new sections (2b, 2c, 2d, 2e, 3f, 2g, 2h, 2i, 2j, 2k, 2l, 2m and 2n).
