**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, December 22, 2020, at 0255 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations (BCI) Special Agent Richard Ward was contacted by BCI Special Agent Supervisor Kevin Barbeau who advised of an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) in the City of Columbus. Additional information reference location was provided to Agent Ward prior to arrival.

At approximately 0445 hours, Agent Ward arrived on scene of Oberlin Drive and Kenny Road, Columbus, Ohio, where the Columbus Police Command bus/ Post was established. Upon arrival, Columbus Police Sergeant Terry McConnell briefed Ward on the circumstances. According to McConnell, two uniformed City of Columbus Police Officers, Adam Coy and Amy Detweiler, responded to a suspicious vehicle, which was described as an SUV turning off and on. The original caller was located at 1054 Oberlin Drive. Officers Coy and Detweiler confronted Andre Hill in the garage/driveway of 1062 Oberlin Ave and Hill was shot by Coy. Hill had been transported to Riverside Hospital prior to Agent Ward's arrival where he was pronounced deceased. Hill was identified via fingerprint identification.

Agent Ward was further briefed that 1062 Oberlin Drive had been cleared and the male homeowner (Bill Wadley) and female friend (Dystanie Lydelle) were detained and placed inside separate Columbus Police vehicles waiting to be interviewed. See Agent Perry Roeser's investigative reports reference those interviews.

Agent Ward and Sergeant McConnell prepared and had signed Franklin County Municipal Court Search Warrants (attached below) for the residence of 1062 Oberlin Drive and the silver Chevrolet Tahoe, Ohio license plate HQA-9019 reportedly driven to the residence by Hill.

While at the scene, Agent Ward conducted a preliminary review of the body worn cameras (BWC) of Officers Coy and Detweiler. Agent Ward requested a walk-through be conducted with Coy and Detweiler prior to the collection of evidence, which was granted. Special Agents

Perry Roeser and Jon Scale were instructed to conduct neighborhood canvasses of the area. Sergeant McConnell provided the call log for this incident and instructed Ward additional information/documents would follow.

Agent Ward observed 1062 Oberlin Drive to be located on the north side of the roadway and described as a two story single family home with an attached garage located on the west portion of the residence. Ward observed the garage door to be open and a white Nissan Altima parked on the right (east) portion of the interior of the garage. Just on the outer portion of the garage, located on the driveway, was a cellular telephone and a green and white cigarette pack. A set of car keys were located just beneath the Altima's rear bumper.
