Narrative:

On November 12, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of Shaker Heights Police Officer David Emlaw (Officer Emlaw) during this incident.

Amped Replay was used to review the video.

SA Valente made a working copy of the BWC video and placed the copied video in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copy of the video was used for the review.

Activity/Notes	This is the last frame of the video.

The video began as Officer Emlaw and a fellow officer blocked access to Yellowstone Road at Mayfield Road with their police cruiser. The two officers then walked to the scene. Once Officer Emlaw reached the general area of the scene he stood in the roadway and spoke with a University Heights Police officer about unrelated matters for approximately 14 minutes while seemingly awaiting direction from Cleveland Heights Police. While speaking with the University Heights Police officer, Officer Emlaw stopped his BWC recording. No derivative works were made from the recording.
