APPROVAL—LEASE TO RESERVOIR LAND AT BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO—BLANCHE E. STRADLEY.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, September 18, 1936.

HON. EARL H. HANEFELD, Director, Department of Agriculture, Columbus, Ohio.

DEAR SIR: I am in receipt of a communication from the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, requesting my approval on a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Blanche E. Stradley of Newark, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years and which provides for an annual rental of \$24.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes, the inner slope and water front and the outer slope and borrow pit adjacent thereto, that is included in the east half of Embankment lot No. 61, west of the waste gates at Buckeye Lake, as laid out by the Ohio Canal Commission on the northerly shore of said lake in 1905, and being part of the Northeast quarter of section 22, town 17, range 18, Fairfield County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
