Narrative:

On Wednesday, April 9, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Steven Seitzman received a Woodlawn Police Department Incident Report from Police Chief Kevin Williams.

SA Seitzman reviewed the report, which detailed an incident that occurred on March 14, 2025, involving the arrest of Samuel Munyarutete. It was reported that during the incident, Munyarutete grabbed the victim by the collar and attempted to strike him with a metal pole while they were at a bus stop in Woodlawn. The victim informed the Woodlawn police officers that Munyarutete was unknown to him. Munyarutete was arrested and taken to the Hamilton County Justice Center where he was held.

The incident report is attached below.


