While Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) was on scene of this incident, he was advised that Sergeant [REDACTED] (Sergeant [REDACTED] was being legally represented by the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP). SA Momchilov was advised that he could speak with FOP representative Chuck Aliff (Aliff) for further information.

On August 23, 2023, SA Momchilov made contact with Aliff via phone. During SA Momchilov's conversation with Aliff, Aliff advised that Sergeant [REDACTED] was being represented by Attorney Kim Corral (Attorney Corral). SA Momchilov then called Attorney Corral but was unsuccessful in reaching her. SA Momchilov did leave a message.

On September 1, 2023, Attorney Corral returned SA Momchilov's phone call. SA Momchilov advised Attorney Corral that he was conducting the investigation into the recent officer-involved shooting that occurred in Howland Township. SA Momchilov advised Attorney Corral that he would like to speak with Sergeant [REDACTED] who reportedly discharged his firearm during the incident.

Attorney Corral advised that she was hesitant to allow Sergeant [REDACTED] to interview with investigators and that the shooting sounded like, "A hero situation."

Attorney Corral that she would think about the interview and let SA Momchilov know. Attorney Corral also stated that she heard this shooting was captured on body-camera footage. SA Momchilov advised that the actual shooting itself was not captured on body-camera footage. Attorney Corral requested a copy of the body-camera footage. SA Momchilov advised Attorney Corral that Ohio BCI would not provide her with any footage of the incident.

As of February 13, 2024, SA Momchilov has not heard back from Attorney Corral.
