Narrative:

On Thursday, March 30, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) reviewed the personnel, training, and Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) Officer Records for Brookfield Township Police Department (BTPD) Sergeant (Sgt.) [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). SA Tingley reviewed the provided documentation and noted the following:

While on a traffic stop on Broadway Ave at Third Street for failure to signal a turn and registration plates not matching the vehicle, this unrelated incident occurred.

I was speaking to the driver of the vehicle when I heard a dog start barking behind me. I turned and saw the dog, belonging to David Bayus, in his yard while he stood in the front door.

I continued speaking with the driver when I heard the dog again. This time the dog was running towards me, barking. The dog left the yard and entered the roadway. I drew my weapon and pointed it at the dog. I yelled at Bayus, who was outside, to get his dog. The dog stopped running towards me when it was approximately ten feet away, standing in the roadway. The dog then ran up the dead end of Third Street and I completed the traffic stop. When I cleared the stop Bayus was still attempting to catch the dog, which had now run down the opposite side of Third Street.

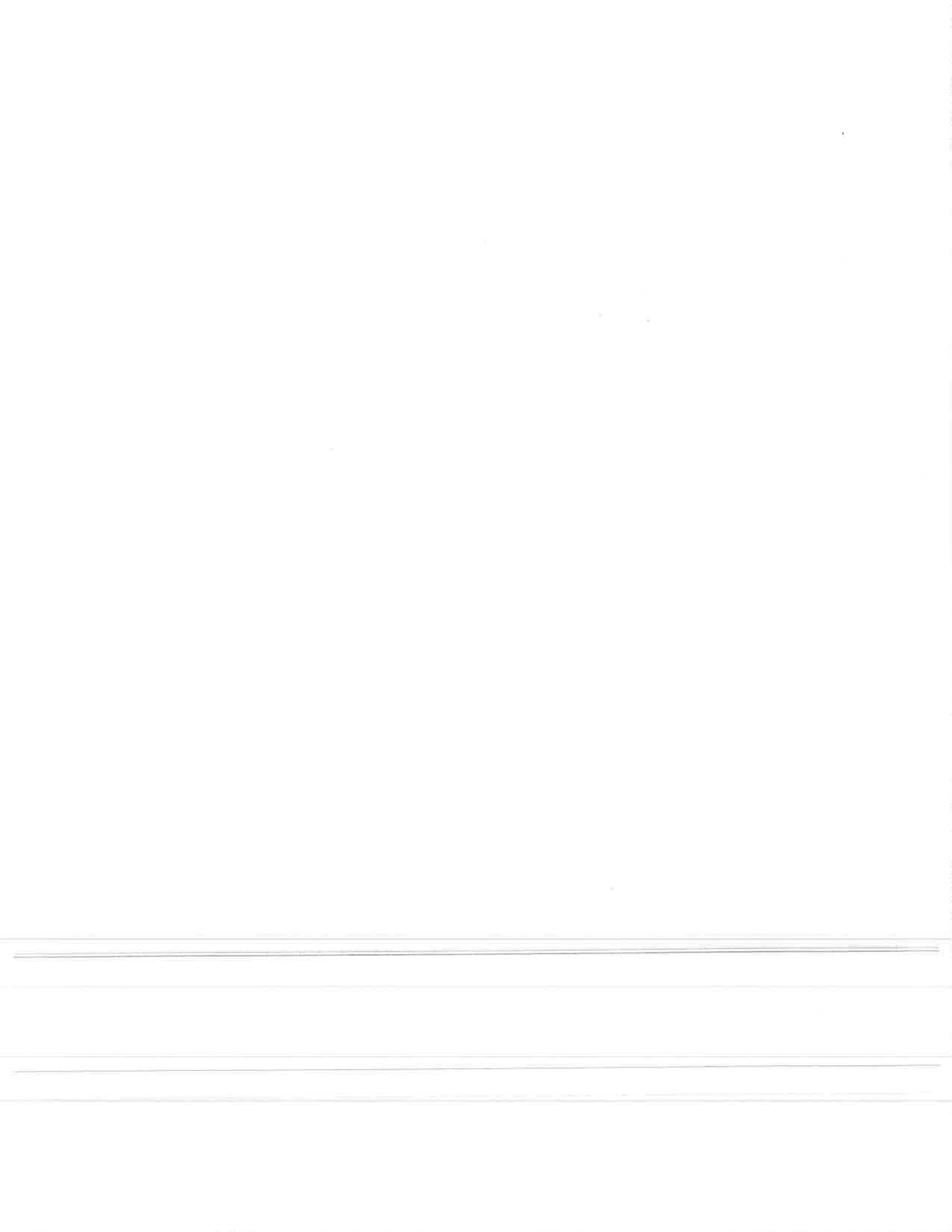

I advised Bayus that I had a summons for him and he refused to open the door, stating the put it in his mailbox. Bayus began recording the encounter on his cell phone camera. Bayus then continued on to say that it was my fault the dog got loose because my lights were on and I was harassing people, which got the dog excited. Bayus stated that he was going to contact the trustees and made more statements accusing me of harassment. I slipped the summons through a large tear in the screen door and he grabbed it from me. Bayus then accused me of ripping his screen. He was advised of his court date and time.

While on a traffic stop on Broadway Ave at Third Street for failure to signal a turn and registration plates not matching the vehicle, this unrelated incident occurred.

I was speaking to the driver of the vehicle when I heard a dog start barking behind me. I turned and saw the dog, belonging to David Bayus, in his yard while he stood in the front door.

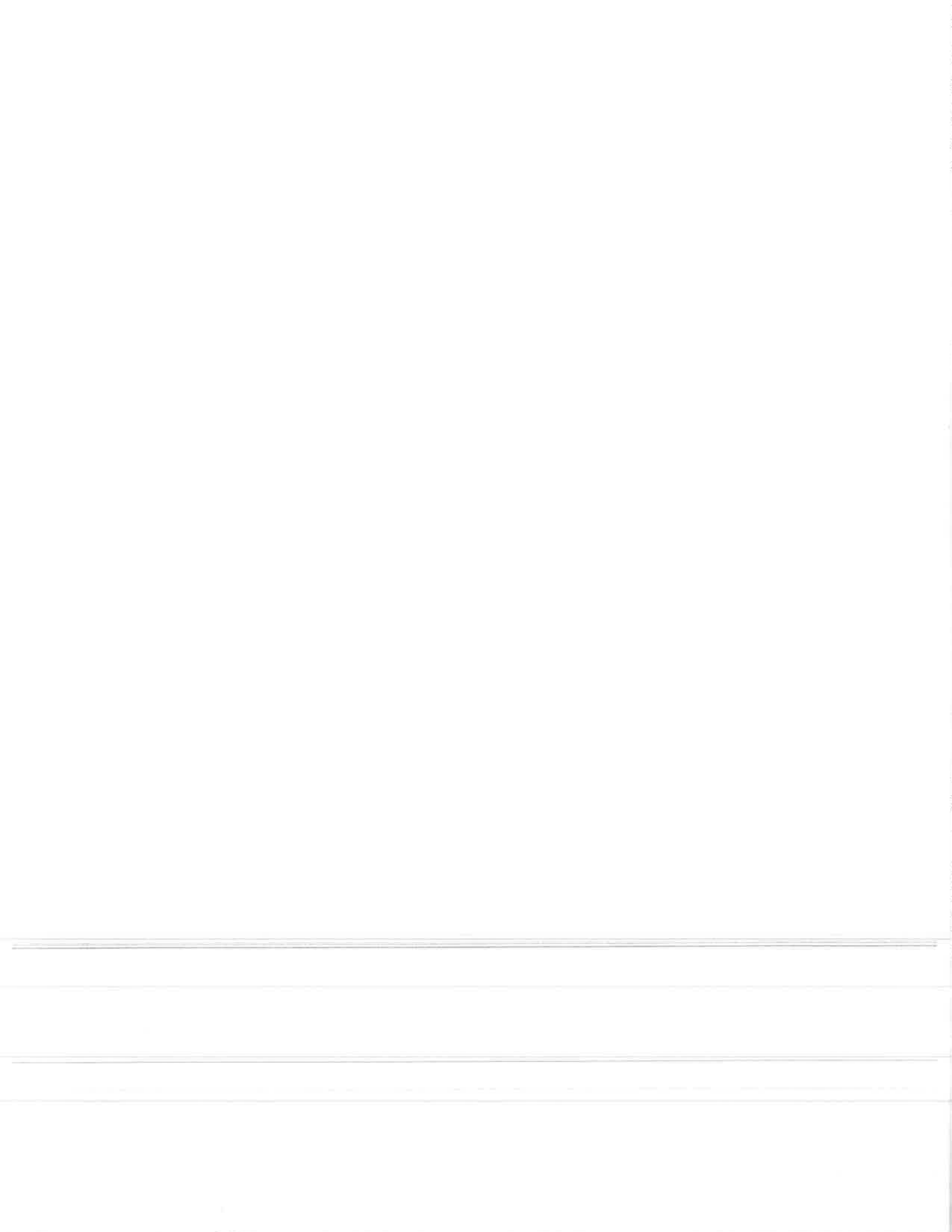
I continued speaking with the driver when I heard the dog again. This time the dog was running towards me, barking. The dog left the yard and entered the roadway. I drew my weapon and pointed it at the dog. I yelled at Bayus, who was outside, to get his dog. The dog stopped running towards me when it was approximately ten feet away, standing in the roadway. The dog then ran up the dead end of Third Street and I completed the traffic stop. When I cleared the stop Bayus was still attempting to catch the dog, which had now run down the opposite side of Third Street.

I completed a summons for confinement of dogs and returned to Bayus' house, allowing him time to catch the dog. I made contact with Bayus at his front door. I advised Bayus that I had a summons for him and he refused to open the door, stating the put it in his mailbox. Bayus began recording the encounter on his cell phone camera. Bayus then continued on to say that it was my fault the dog got loose because my lights were on and I was harassing people, which got the dog excited. Bayus stated that he was going to contact the trustees and made more statements accusing me of harassment. I slipped the summons through a large tear in the screen door and he grabbed it from me. Bayus then accused me of ripping his screen. He was advised of his court date and time.

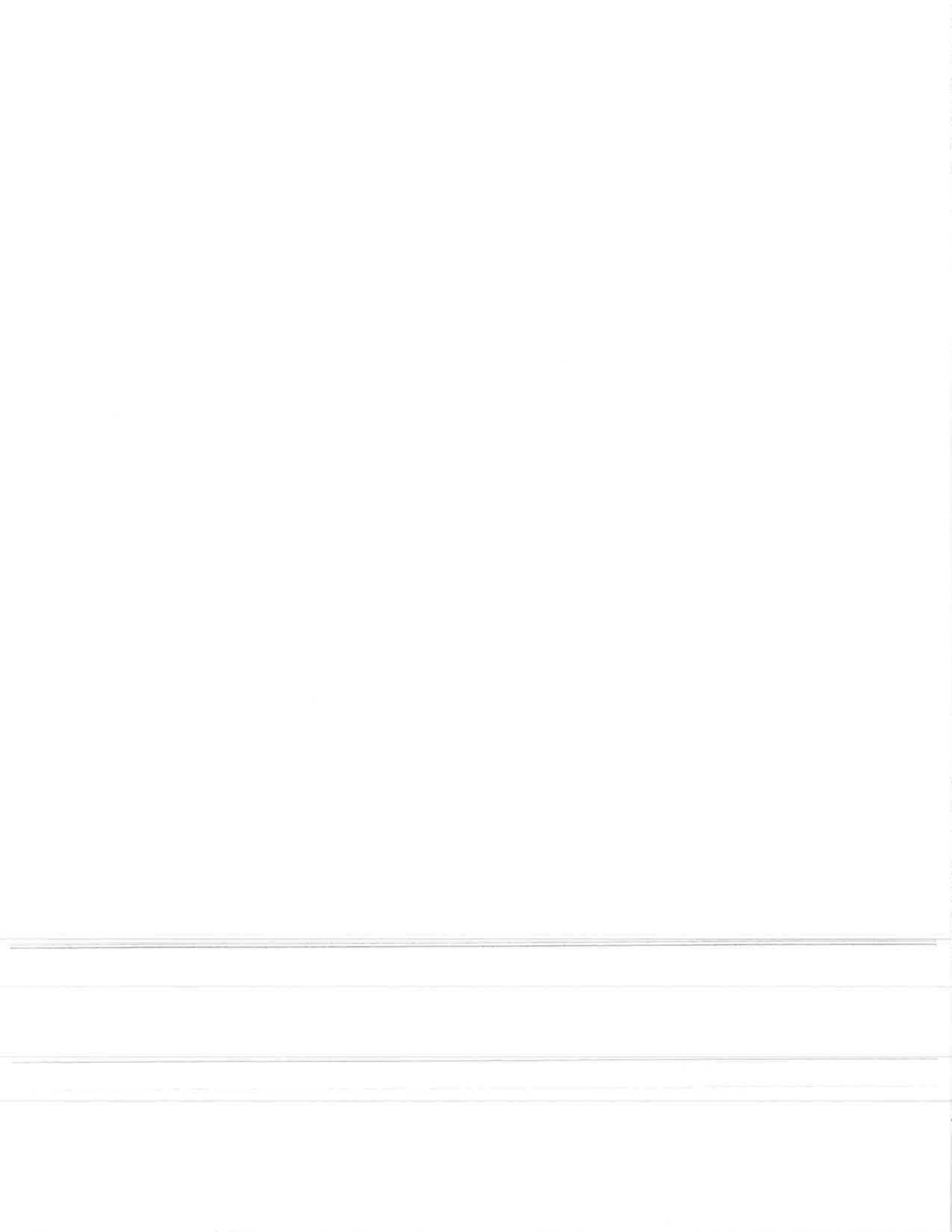
