Narrative:

On December 31, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (Burke) spoke with Mercer County Coroner (MCC), Doctor (Dr.) Timothy Heinrichs (Heinrichs) about the death of Moses Alik (Moses). Dr. Heinrichs said he had been notified of the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) and the death of Moses.

SA Burke asked Dr. Heinrichs if he was going to be responding to the scene (303 S. Main St. Celina, OH, Dockside's Marathon Gas Station) or Coldwater Hospital to observe the body of Moses. Dr. Heinrichs stated he would not be responding to the scene or the hospital to observe the body of Moses. Dr. Heinrichs added, he had already spoke with medical personnel from Coldwater Hospital, in Coldwater, OH, where Moses had been pronounced deceased. According to Dr. Heinrichs, he had already released the body of Moses to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office (MCCC) for an autopsy/toxicology to be conducted.

Dr. Heinrichs had no further relevant information and SA Burke ended the conversation with Dr. Heinrichs.
