DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works, for the Department of Public Welfare, and The Atlas Electric Company of Norwood, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of Contract for Electrical Work for a project known as Completion of T. B. Cottage, Longview State Hospital, Cincinnati, Ohio, in accordance with Item No. 4 of the form of proposal dated March 14, 1935. Said contract calls for an expenditure of seventeen hundred and forty dollars (\$1740.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. You have also submitted a certificate of the Controlling Board showing that such board has released funds for this project in accordance with Section 1 of House Bill No. 69 of the second special session of the 90th General Assembly.

In addition, you have submitted a contract bond upon which the American Bonding Company of Baltimore appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.
