Narrative:

On Thursday, September 01, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Eric Lehnhart (Lehnhart) compiled background information on Elizabeth Ann Delano (Delano), a subject involved in the incident on Monday, August 22, 2022. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Knox County Sheriff's Office.

SA Lehnhart reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Police Encounters:

Delano had prior encounters or involvement with the Knox County Sheriff's Office and the Ohio State Highway Patrol. Outside of the typical traffic offenses, Delano's criminal activity consisted of disorderly conduct, obstructing official business and possession of marijuana charges.

I was contacted by CPS worker Dan Brady in regards to an allegation of sex abuse between 14 year old Westen Pugh and 4 year old brother Pierce Delano. Pierce disclosed to his mother that Westen had put his "weenie" in his mouth and touched Pierce's butt with his "weenie". This allegedly occurred while the two boys were showering together, as they sometimes do. Dan Brady spoke with Westen on February 10, 2016 at Mount Vernon Middle School. Westen was aware of Pierce's disclosure but adamantly denied ever touching Pierce because "that would be inappropriate". Westen stated he and Pierce do not shower together often, but do occasionally shower together and Westen has to occasionally help Pierce wash his hair. Westen stated recently Pierce got into the shower with him and they were both washing themselves. Pierce then urinated on Westen and they both thought that was funny and Westen began tickling Pierce. Westen reported both boys slipped on soap on the shower floor and Westen fell on top of Pierce. Westen stated their penises may have touched during that time, but only accidentally and not in a sexual way. Westen again denied ever touching Pierce's mouth or buttocks with his penis. Westen advised he believes Pierce knows about those behaviors from watching inappropriate YouTube videos. Dan Brady spoke with Pierce, and his mother Elizabeth Delano on March 7, 2016 at KCDJFS. Pierce had difficulty determining the difference between the truth and a lie, but was able to understand right and wrong. Pierce did appear to understand safe and unsafe touches. Pierce stated Westen had touched him in the shower once and put his "manhood" (Pierce's word for penis) in his mouth and "pooper" (Pierce's word for buttocks). Pierce stated he urinated on Westen and they thought that was funny so Westen tickled him and they both slipped on soap and fell in the shower. Pierce stated he did not like the oral and anal sex and did not want to do that again. Pierce was often distracted and would begin talking about video games or toys until he was redirected.

On Thursday, July 21, 2016 I was dispatched to 1625 New Gambier Rd. on a 911 hang-up complaint. Dispatch advised they received a 911 hang-up call at this residence and they were attempting to call the number back. While en-route to the location dispatch advised they got ahold of Derek Delano who advised them that his daughter Alaina had just gotten into trouble and she called. Upon my arrival I made contact with both Derek and Alaina. Derek advised me that Alaina had just gotten into trouble and that she wasn't even suppose to have a phone. I asked Alaina why she had called 911 and she advised me that she didn't mean to that she was trying to call a friend out of state and that phone number starts with 91. While speaking to Derek and Alaina, a vehicle pulled into the drive-way and it was Alaina's mother Elizabeth Delano. Elizabeth joined our conversation and asked that I take Alaina away from them and maybe she would talk to me more. I took Alaina over towards my cruiser and she advised me that she got into trouble for breaking something that she didn't break. Alaina stated that Derek had told her that she was only going to have bread and water for dinner. Alaina stated that this upset her and that was when I asked Alaina how upset she was. Alaina stated she wanted to take her necklace and wrap it around her neck and kill herself. I asked Alaina if she had ever had these type of thoughts before and she stated that she has. I went back and spoke to Elizabeth and Derek and advised them of the comment that Alaina had made to me and advised them that I thought she needed to be seen at the emergency room for evaluation. Elizabeth advised that she agreed but asked if I would transport Alaina to the emergency room. I took Alaina to the emergency room and was advised to take her into the lobby (waiting area). While waiting in the lobby one of the nurses came out and advised that our wait was going to be almost two hours if not a little longer. While waiting Dean Owens from Behavioral Healthcare Partners called me back. I advised Dean the situation and the wait that the emergency room had given us and he advised that he would be en-route and that he would be there in about twenty minutes. Once Dean came on scene at the emergency room I left after he spoke to Alaina for a few minutes.

The complainant Natasha called the Sheriffs Office to file a report concerning a complaint from one of her clients in reference to an employee being verbally abusive, and conducting themselves in a manner which is not appropriate. Natasha, who works for Via Quest out of Dublin Ohio, stated that a client of theirs, Michael Williams, was claiming that the involved party, Elizabeth Delano was being verbally abusive towards him and that Elizabeth had purchased alcohol and drank it while driving Michael around in a vehicle. Natasha advised me that Michael is a high functioning developmentally disabled individual. I spoke with Elizabeth to get her side of the alleged incident. Elizabeth stated that she had injured her back while working several weeks ago and that she has not even worked with Michael for at least two weeks. The alleged incident supposedly happened on 10/17/2016. Elizabeth stated that she has never been verbally abusive towards Michael or any other clients and she most definitely did not purchase or consume any alcohol with any of her clients present. Elizabeth was offered a statement to which she accepted and filled out. A report was made at the request of Natasha per Via Quest.

On Friday, January 6, 2017 I was advised that Jace Cree wanted to speak to an officer about a possible Child Abuse complaint. I contacted Jace via telephone and he advised me that he had received information that one of his clients may have been a victim of child abuse. Jace advised, he received a call that Westen Pugh may have been abused by his mother Elizabeth Delano. I went to 1625 New Gambier Rd. where Elizabeth and Westen live in an attempt to make contact with all parties involved in the incident. I was only able to make contact with Derek Delano. Derek advised that he was upstairs in bed when he heard a commotion between Elizabeth and Westen. Derek advised that Westen was cussing and yelling at his mother. Derek said that Elizabeth told Westen several times to stop cussing and yelling or she was going to slap him. Derek then heard Westen say that he would fight back and that is when he got up out of bed. Derek said when he got out of the bedroom he witnessed a little scuffle between Westen and Elizabeth and observed Elizabeth smack Westen in the face. Derek said that Westen then attempted to run out of the house and was dragging his mom out of the house with him. Derek went outside and brought both of them back into the residence. Derek said that's when he noticed Westen's nose was bleeding and they began treating the bloody nose. I asked Derek if he would fill out a statement and he stated that he would. The interaction that I had with Derek was recorded on my body worn camera. I then went to 206 S. Mulberry St. and spoke to Westen Pugh and Frank Kroninger. I advised them that I was there to speak to Westen about what happened at his residence this morning between him and his mother. Westen advised me that he got up this morning and walked to the kitchen to get his medication. Westen was told by his mother to get another pill for his sister so he grabbed two pills. Westen then went to get a cup out of a drawer and he said that his sister then rushed past him and grabbed a cup which made him mad. Westen said he began yelling at his sister that she could have waited a fucking minute. Westen then takes his medication and goes into the living room and continued cussing. Westen's mother tells him to stop cussing or she would smack him. Westen said that he then told his mother that he would fight back. Westen then said that his mom then gets up and try's to smack him and he try's pushing her back. Westen said that his mom then smacks him the neck, so he began cussing at her and pushed her away from him. Westen said that she then came back at him and smacked him three times in the face hitting his nose causing it to bleed. Westen said that's when he tried to leave the house because his nose was bleeding pretty bad. Westen said that his hands and clothes got covered in blood and that his parents then brought him back into the residence. Westen stated once they got inside the residence things started to calm down and his mom got a paper towel and had him cover his nose. Westen said that he was told to change clothes and a coat so things could be washed before they leave to speak to their family consoler (Abby). Frank advised me that when he arrived at Westen's house to get him around 4:00 p.m. there was blood on the walk-way in front of the front door. Frank wrote a report for Knox County Board of DD and I was provided a copy of his report. My interaction between Westen and Frank was video recorded from my body worn camera. I made contact with on-call Children Services and advised them of the situation. They advised they were aware of the situation and that they were okay with Westen going back home this evening and that they wanted a copy of my report for their investigation. I will forward a copy of my report to Knox County Children Services and to Mount Vernon City Law Director's Office for review. I was able to gather a statement from Elizabeth Delano after she got off of work. Elizabeth's statement says that Westen was making valger statements towards her. She said while attempting him to stop she smacked him in the mouth and he then stormed out of the house. Elizabeth writes while attempting to get Westen back in the house she grabbed Westen by his chest and back his nose began to bleed. Elizabeth stated they got him back in the house and gave him first aid for his nose bleed. While walking up to the residence to gather Elizabeth's statement I did observe blood on the walk way in front of the residence. There was several drops of blood on the ground that lead from the front door to about twenty feet away from the residence. This interaction was also recorded on my body worn camera.

On Tuesday, August 15, 2017 Lt. Tim Light and I were dispatched to an active domestic violence complaint at 1625 New Gambier Rd. Dispatch advised they received a call from Westen Pugh advising that his sister Alaina Pugh was out of control being physical with their mother Elizabeth Delano. Westen advised that his mother had his sister pinned down on the floor trying to calm her down. Upon our arrival Westen was outside waiting for us. Westen said that everything had started over dishes and his sister began getting physical with their mother. Westen stated that his mother was still inside sitting/laying on top of his sister trying to get her to calm down. Lt. Light and I went to the front door. As we approached the front door I could hear yelling inside the residence. We entered into the residence and I observed two females on the floor. I saw that Elizabeth was on top of Alaina, and Alaina was still yelling and moving around as if she was trying to get away from Elizabeth. Elizabeth and I went outside to talk and Lt. Light stayed with Alaina. Elizabeth told me that she asked all of her children to finish their chores in the morning. She advised me that Alaina had not completed her chores so she grounded her from all of her electronics. Elizabeth also stated that she took a pair of pants and a shirt also as part of her punishment. Elizabeth stated that this upset Alaina and she began to yell and also started becoming physical with her. Elizabeth stated that Alaina began kicking, punching, and biting her. Elizabeth showed me a mark on her right arm that was already starting to bruise and you could tell that it was a bite mark. Elizabeth stated that Alaina had caused the mark from biting her. Elizabeth advised that Alaina had no where else she could go tonight and stated that she felt unsafe if Alaina stayed at the residence tonight. I went inside to see what Lt. Light had found out and I observed that Alaina was still laying on the floor and that she hadn't moved from the location I last seen her at. Lt. Light advised that Alaina hadn't told him anything about what had happened. I advised him of what Elizabeth had told me and Alaina stated that sounded correct. I made contact with the on-call Juvenile Probation officer and advised him of the situation. I advised him that from what I could tell I had a domestic violence situation and that Alaina was the primary physical aggressor. He advised me that I could take Alaina to Muskingum County Juvenile Detention Center. I took photographs of the residence and of Elizabeth and of her wound on her arm. I went inside the residence to have Alaina come out to my cruiser and she was up walking around inside the residence. We gathered Alaina's medication and she was taken outside. Once outside I observed a scratch mark on Alaina's neck and that was photographed as well. I placed handcuff's on Alaina making sure they were gapped and double locked. Alaina was then transported and released to Muskingum County Juvenile Detention Center. This incident was recorded on my body warn camera. 

She said that Elizabeth had let her dog out without a leash and had been chasing her and her siblings around. Alaina said that Elizabeth pushed her in the back and went inside to get another drink. Alaina let us into the house and as I entered, I could smell the strong odor of pet urine and garbage. Things were piled up on the surfaces and the floor and I could see half eaten food open in the kitchen. Deputy Thomas went to speak with the children and I went to talk to Elizabeth. I made contact with Elizabeth in the kitchen of the home. She was unsteady on her feet and had slurred speech. I could see several empty containers of Modelo beer and Mike's Harder Lemonade. Elizabeth sat down on the floor and I began to talk to her to try and figure out what was going on. She was unable to follow any train of thought and struggled to answer my questions. I asked what day it was and she said Wednesday or Thursday, I told her it was Sunday and later I asked her what day it was and she answered Tuesday. She didn't remember how many children there were in the house, initially telling me six when there were only four. She was also unsure of where her husband Derek was, she kept saying he was in the house and I should ask him these questions. She said that Deputy Thomas and I were called to help the dogs switch over "from AM to PM" and was unable to follow any logical train of thought. I was very concerned about Elizabeth's level of impairment. Alaina said that she is on several medications that may interact badly with alcohol. I had a medic dispatched to the residence to make sure she was all right. Medics arrived and transported Elizabeth to Knox Community Hospital for evaluation. Alaina said that she had never seen her mother act like this before. She said that she had been intoxicated before, but had never "zoned out" to this point. Alaina said that she was afraid because her mother was not making sense and was acting aggressively. She said that when Elizabeth started to go after her ten year old brother, Pierce and her thirteen year old sister Helene, she called 911. She said that her father, Derek was on his way back home from Columbus and would be there soon. I spoke to Derek on the phone and filled him in on the situation. A report was taken and will be sent to the city law director for review and children's services.

The complainant, Chelsea Davis, advised multiple people were actively fighting in the parking lot. Parties were separated and a report was sent down for possible charges. I arrived on scene and made contact with Deputy Nally who arrived prior to me and was speaking with involved party, Sherri Hess. I advised that I would speak with the other parties involved. I spoke with Alaina Pugh. Alaina stated that she was driving east on Coshocton Ave. into Howard and observed a tan honda, tailgating her. Alaina stated while approaching the 35mph zone in Howard she began to slow down, turned on her left turn signal and turned into the Dollar General parking lot. Selby and I remained en route to investigate the incident.

Elizabeth was downstairs in the basement passed-out in a chair. I went outside with Derek to talk about the situation. Derek stated that Elizabeth has been abusing alcohol for about a year. He stated that Elizabeth had already hit Westen before he "physically" moved her away and told her to go sleep outside in a vehicle.

I went back inside and Sgt. Selby advised that the story from Weston and Alaina was the same. Sgt. Selby and I walked downstairs to where Elizabeth was passed-out. Elizabeth was intoxicated and talked with slurred speech. She was not co-operative with our questioning. Sgt. Selby asked her why she called for a squad and she said because she wanted us to stop Derek. I asked her what would happen if we left the residence and she said, "that's what the second amendment is for."

Elizabeth wanted to smoke a cigarette so she went outside the walkout basement door. I made contact again with Westen, Alaina and Derek to asked them about charges. Westen said that he didn't want charges. Derek said that they just want her behavior to stop, referring to her drinking problem.

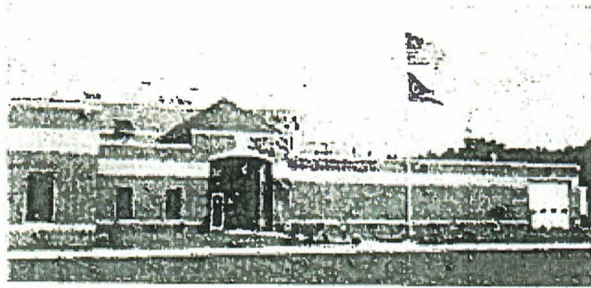
Deputy Sindel and I responded to 1625 New Gambier Rd. in reference to 9 year old, Peirce Delano, intentionally overdosing on Tylenol, Adderall, and Zoloft. We arrived at the residence and located father, Derek Delano, mother, Elizabeth Delano, and Peirce in the driveway. I stepped out of my vehicle and Elizabeth brought Peirce to me and stated "Here you take him." Peirce was lethargic and was having trouble standing. I held Peirce up and was talking to him in an attempt to keep him conscious. Deputy Sindel spoke with Elizabeth in an attempt to figure out exactly what Peirce had ingested. Derek held Peirce for a minute and then placed him on the trunk of their vehicle. We kept Peirce awake until EMS personnel arrived. They transported Peirce to Knox Community Hospital for treatment.

I spoke with Derek after EMS personnel had left. Derek advised this happened "out of no where". He said Peirce's older sister had overdosed in December and that was where he may have learned what to do. Derek advised Peirce has been "up and down" and upset because of the recent "turmoil" in the family. Derek advised he has custody of his children and Elizabeth is under supervised visitation. Derek advised Elizabeth was over for Easter dinner and had spent some time with Peirce. Derek said he was in bed getting ready to go to sleep when Peirce knocked on his door. Derek stated Peirce told him, "There's something wrong with my head and just took..." Derek stated this, this, and this, referring to the Tylenol, Adderall and Zoloft. Derek further advised Peirce has a case manager with Behavioral Health Partners, and also sees a social worker at school. I advised Derek that he should also look into taking Peirce to Nationwide Children's Hospital to speak with their mental health professionals as well.

Derek and I then responded to KCH to meet up with Deputy Sindel and Elizabeth.

Deputy Sindel and I briefed the hospital staff on the incident. They advised Peirce would be held for observation due to their acetaminophen protocol. They advised they would contact us if they needed anything further. Deputy Sindel and I spoke with Derek again. He was reminded of Children's hospital and that our recommendation was to take him there for further treatment. We also advised him to follow up with their case manager with BHP. Derek advised he had our contact information and would reach out if he needed any further assistance.



On 09/29/2021, Deputy Williams, Deputy Wise, and I were dispatched to 1625 New Gambier Rd. In Mt. Vernon, Ohio, on a disturbance. The complainant, Alaina Pugh, called 911 to report that her mother, Elizabeth Delano, who was not allowed at the home and has not stayed there since July of 2020, was at the home without her father's permission. Elizabeth's son, Westen Pugh, and Alaina both stated that their mother showed up uninvited and began to take jewelry, documents, and firearms. Alaina said that her father, Derek Delano, has instructed them that Elizabeth is not allowed to be there and because of her drug and alcohol addiction that Child Protective Services has issued an order that grants Elizabeth visitation, but only at Derek's discretion. Derek and Elizabeth are still married, but separated.

Upon arrival I spoke with Alaina and she said that her mother was still inside with her sister Helene Delano. Alaina then made the statement that her mother was armed with a handgun. Deputy Williams and I moved Alaina, Westen, and their younger brother, Pierce Delano to a safer location, and then approached the front door with sidearms at low ready. When I peered in the screen door I could see an older female going through a small desk with her back to me. I opened the door and she turned and told me to leave and get out of the house. I did not see anything in her hands or in the immediate area and holstered my sidearm. Elizabeth then started back peddling further into the living room, at which time I grabbed her wrist. She then began to resist trying to pull away from me. I then grabbed her other arm and placed them behind her as she continued to struggle. During the altercation Elizabeth yelled out, "I have a gun", which I took as a threat. Deputy Williams handcuffed her as I held her arms. Deputy Williams then pat her down and did find an unloaded magazine belonging to a 9mm Taurus handgun. After conducting a pat down we did not locate a gun. I then told Elizabeth she was in investigative custody until we figure out what is going on. She then started yelling obscenities and calling names. I warned her to stop with the young children there and she was even louder. I placed her in my cruiser, and she began to call her daughter Alaina a fucking bitch over and over because she was going to jail now.

I then went back into the home to secure the weapons Alaina was talking about. I finally met the younger daughter, Helene, at the front door. Helene pointed out to me were the two guns Elizabeth was trying to take. There was a small case containing a 9mm Taurus that was not loaded but did have a fully loaded magazine with it. There was also an unidentified rifle in a soft rifle case. I asked Helene what had happened? Helene story matched both siblings explanation of what had happened. I then secured both weapons in the trunk of my cruiser.

I tried several times to speak with Elizabeth and ask her questions, but she would not give me straight answers. She did tell me she her probation officer was Joel Carter. Dispatch was able to connect me with Joel. I explained to him what was happening. Joel asked how she actually got to the home because she was currently staying at 102 Hillcrest Dr. in Mt. Vernon at Riverside Recovery and that her vehicle was in their care and Elizabeth did not have access to it. I advise she had told me that she had a pass to leave and had walked to Superior Auto in Mt. Vernon and was test driving one of their vehicles. Joel said that he would put a holder on her and that she knows she has no business being over there.

Elizabeth then started to rock my cruiser and was banging her head on the side window. I opened the door and warned her to stop. I then advised her that she was being arrested and charged with Obstructing Official Business 2921.31(A) and Disorderly Conduct Persisting 2917.11(A)(3), 2917.11(E)(3)(a). She again started yelling obscenities, but stopped for the moment. Several minutes later, Elizabeth laid down in the seat and began to kick the door panel and side window, leaving foot prints on both. At that time Deputy Wise and Deputy Williams opened both back doors telling her to stop. I retrieved my hobbles and held Elizabeth down on her side while Deputy Williams adjusted and double locked her handcuffs. I then placed the hobble on to stop her from kicking and then rolled her onto her side.

I then turned custody of the firearms over to Deputy Wise. I then transported Elizabeth to the Knox County Jail. Elizabeth called me a pedophile and several other names on the short ride over. She also spit all over the back seat and rear seat divider. Elizabeth continued to cuss and call names after jail staff started their booking procedure.

I then returned to the home to speak with the father, Derek, who was still on his way from Columbus. Once there he provided me with a copy of court papers that do award him custody of the two minor children Pierce and Helene. He also showed me documents from Child Protective Services that he claims says that Elizabeth is only to be around the two minor children at his discretion. I could not read the copies on Derek's phone so he agreed to send a copy to my e-mail. The firearms were returned to Derek and I advised that he may want to lock his guns up because Elizabeth was not in a mental position to be handling them or be near them. Derek said he would take them to a friend's house until a resolution was reached through his divorce proceedings and marital property could be divided. Derek also said that he would be filing for a temporary restraining order to protect the children.

The vehicle was searched at Joel's request but nothing other than Elizabeth's personal items were in the car. I later took those items to the jail to be added to Elizabeth's property.

Superior Auto was then contacted and allowed to come and pick up their vehicle. Superior Auto had stated to dispatch that they only had lent the car for 15 minutes test drive and that it was gone for over an hour and was going to report it stolen.



**JUDGMENT ENTRY:
ANNUAL REVIEW HEARING**

This matter came before this Court for an Annual Review Hearing on March 17, 2021. Present in Court were:

- Glenette "BJ" James of KCDJFS with Attorney Ashley Johns
- Attorney D. Derk Demaree on behalf of Mother
- Derek Delano, Father of Helene and Pierce
- The following parties failed to appear for this hearing despite receiving notice of the same: Elizabeth Delano, Mother and Jason Pugh, Father of Alaina.

The last hearing in this matter was held on December 16, 2020 and addressed a Review of this matter. At that time, KCDJFS was continued Protective Supervision of this matter. In an agreed entry filed on January 12, 2021 KCDJFS was granted Temporary Custody of Alaina.

The Court hereby finds:

This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this proceeding. The Court advised the parties of the nature of the case and the status of the proceedings and determined that all notice and service requirements had been met.

The Court determined that the parties present entitled to counsel were represented or had knowingly and voluntarily waived their rights to counsel and court-appointed counsel if indigent.

KCDJFS requested to continue Alaina in the Temporary Custody of KCDJFS with visitation at the discretion of KCDJFS and grant Father Legal Custody of Helene and Pierce and terminate KCDJFS involvement.

Father advised the Court that a Divorce pending and was in agreement with the requests of KCDJFS.

Attorney Demaree advised the Court that he has not had contact with Mother since January, 2021 and objects to custody to Father.

The Court further finds:

Efforts made by KCDJFS to work with the family have been reasonable and appropriate and are consistent with the child(ren)'s best interest.

KCDJFS has used reasonable efforts to prevent removal of the child(ren) from the home, to remedy the conditions that led to removal of the child(ren), make it possible for the child(ren) to return home, and to establish permanency for the child(ren). Specifically, the Court finds these reasonable efforts based upon the following actions taken by KCDJFS: Case planning and CRC placement.

The Case Plan previously approved and journalized in this matter continues to be an **ORDER** of this Court, and the parties are directed to follow the same.

The following orders are in the best interest of Alaina and it is hereby **ORDERED** that the same will remain in effect until further Order of this Court: Alaina Pugh (DOB: 3/15/2003) shall continue in the Temporary Custody of KCDJFS with visitation at the discretion of KCDJFS.

It is, further, **ORDERED**, that a further review hearing regarding Alaina Pugh shall be held in this matter on the 2nd day of August, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. in the Knox County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division.


The Court further finds that based upon these efforts, KCDJFS has established a permanency plan for the child(ren) through a grant of Legal Custody to Father. It is therefore **ORDERED** that Helene Delano (DOB: 8/17/2006); and Pierce Delano (DOB: 10/11/2011) are hereby placed in the Legal Custody of Derek Delano, Father.

The Court does not issue any specific visitation orders regarding Helene or Peirce herein, however, the parties may file future motions with the Court seeking visitation.


It is, further, **ORDERED**, that KCDJFS involvement in the matters of Helene and Peirce, including the previously ordered Protective Supervision is hereby terminated.

The foregoing disposition of Legal Custody is intended to be a permanent placement to establish permanency and stability for Helene and Pierce, consistent with R.C. 2151.42. The matters of Helene and Peirce will not come before the Court for any additional review hearings unless proper Motion of a party herein is filed with the Court. As such, any future hearing dates in the matters of Helene and Pierce are hereby **VACATED**.
