**Narrative:**

On May 3, 2024, Special Agent (SA) Josh Rammel (Rammel) and Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Scott Stranahan (Stranahan) conducted a canvass interview with Austin Wagner (Wagner) regarding the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred at 121 West Perry Street, Tiffin, Ohio, on May 3, 2024.

The interview was conducted at Wagner's address of 123 1/2 West Perry Street, Tiffin, Ohio; near the location of the OICI. The interview was recorded using a digital audio recorder. A copy of the interview was attached to this investigation.

SA Rammel and SAS Stranahan identified themselves and provided the reason for the contact. Wagner provided basic identifiers such as his date of birth, address, and phone number.

Wagner advised that he was not home when the OICI occurred, and that the first motion that was detected on his Blink Camera was the Tiffin Police Department conducting their initial canvass, walking up onto Wagner's porch.

Wagner used his hands and showed an approximate location as to where the camera would begin to pick up motion, while indicating that Wagner had it set for people coming onto the porch because otherwise it would pick up all the traffic from cars driving on West Perry Street.

Wagner advised that he would contact his neighbor so that she could come out and speak with SA Rammel and SAS Stranahan in the event that she had additional information.

Wagner indicated that the third apartment in his building was vacant currently.

Wagner advised that he did not have any additional information that he could provide regarding the OICI, and the interview was concluded.

This report only summarizes the information deemed by the author to be of the most relevance to the investigation and does not purport to contain all questions and answers from the interview. Further, this report was placed in a chronology to aid the reader's overall understanding of the information elicited during the interview and may not be reflective of the actual sequencing of questions. It is suggested that the full recording be reviewed to clarify
