

#### Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 11, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Chuck Moran (SAS Moran) downloaded two video files from body-worn cameras (BWC) for Youngstown Police Department (YPD)

The video files were located in the BCI case file in evidence.com in the folder labeled as Reference Item C. The videos were:


It is recommended that the viewer review the videos, images, and reports in this order:

#### **REVIEW**

SAS Moran imported the videos into Amped Replay for review. SAS Moran generated bookmarked images for each video and Amped Replay reports for each video.

Linderman's arms were extended outward toward (as if he was lunging or reaching for Linderman's right hand was in a fist with an object (unknown in it) and his left hand was open. pistol appeared to malfunction (possibly jam, slide still moved to rear/out of battery).

# Additional Factors to Consider When Evaluating Digital Multimedia Evidence (DME)


Based upon SAS Moran's training and experience, the following factors should be considered when evaluating the available video evidence:

- The speed of this incident is remarkable.
- The speed and complexity of rapidly evolving situation(s) that occur during useof-force encounters are difficult concepts to comprehend by only watching the video.
- Video and audio recording devices record more information about a particular scene or incident than the person(s) involved in the event can process during the critical incident.
- Video and audio recording devices rarely record an event from the same perspective of the officer(s) or subject(s) involved.
- It captures the action but not the perception, decision-making, focus nor intent of the officer(s).
- Video recordings often miss tactile cues or other actions of a subject.
- Video and audio recording devices record within the video and sound capabilities available, and they record objectively.
- Video and audio recordings lack the history, perspective and interest of the people involved.
- The movements, positions, angles, obstacles, lighting, and distance from the incident are also factors that need serious consideration.
- Video recordings are for storage and review.
- Video recordings capture light and create a digital representation of reality (twodimensional video compared to three-dimensional reality).
- Video and audio recordings are only components of an investigation and should not be the only evidence relied upon.
- All available evidence, statements and other information must be evaluated alongside the video recordings available.
