Narrative:

On November 14, 2025, at 2026 hours, SA Holcomb was assigned to assist the Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSP), West Union Police Department (WUPD) and the Adams County Sheriff's Office with an officer involved critical incident. SA Holcomb responded to the OSP Brown County patrol post located at 9240 US-68, Georgetown, OH 45121 where the involved troopers and WUPD officer were located at.

SA Holcomb photographed each trooper and officer as they were upon arrival. The following firearms were collected from the involved individuals:
