APPROVAL, CONTRACT BETWEEN STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC WORKS, ON BEHALF OF DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE AND FREEMAN & JONES, INC., CLEVELAND, OHIO, GENERAL CONTRACT FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, HAWTHORNDEN, CLEVELAND STATE HOSPITAL, CLEVELAND, OHIO, \$46,700—HARTFORD ACCIDENT AND INDEMNITY COMPANY, SURETY.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, for and on behalf of the Department of Public Welfare, and Freeman & Jones, Inc., of Cleveland, Ohio. This contract covers the general contract for sewage disposal plant (exclusive of Filter Beds Nos. 5 and 6, at Hawthornden, Cleveland State Hospital, Cleveland, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of forty-six thousand seven hundred dollars (\$46,700.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. There has further been submitted a contract bond upon which the Hartford Accident and Indemnity Company appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.

You have further submitted evidence indicating that plans were properly prepared and approved, notice to bidders was properly given, bids tabulated as required by law and the contract duly awarded. Also it appears that the laws relating to the status of surety companies and the workmen's compensation have been complied with.

Finding said contract and bond in proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with all other data submitted in this connection.
