**Narrative:**

On April 9, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the recorded phone call between Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP) Investigations Section Sergeant Shawn Allar (Allar) and witness Walter Pase (Pase) which occurred on April 3, 2026. Sergeant Allar had recorded the phone call and provided a copy of the recording to SA Tingley.

This report only summarizes the information from the phone interview of Pase by Sergeant Allar and only summarizes the information deemed by the author to be of the most relevance to the investigation and does not purport to contain all the statement of Pase or the questions and answers that occurred during the interview. The quotations listed will be a word for word translation of the interview from the audio recording.

As there is no date or time stamp on the recording, the times listed will be the elapsed time from the beginning of the recording.

SA Tingley reviewed the recording and noted the following:

At 00:30, Sergeant Allar asked:

*"Who contacted you in regard to uh, that individual being on your property?"*

At 00:40, Pace replied:

*"Uh, ... this is Jim Grant's property..." "I'm his brother...I'm the one that, that lives in the camper."*

At 00:52, Sergeant Allar then asked:

*"Can you tell me what happened that evening?"*

At 01:01 Pase stated:

*"Well, me and my girlfriend was in the camper...and we was taking, going to take the dog out to use the bathroom. Well, we got off the porch, and he came around the side...came around the side and pointed a gun."*

The interview continued with Sergeant Allar getting more information from Pase as well as information about Pase's girlfriend, Rebecca Grim.

Then at 01:46 Pase said:

*"The dude said, whoa, whoa, uh, don't move...Well the dude was trying to ask questions about what was all he was involved in and all this..."*

Pase continued and at 02:38 stated:

*"The dude went; the dude already had my winter coat on. That was the big green one...The dude used my clippers, my, uh, battery operated clippers to cut his facial hair."*

At this point, Sergeant Allar began verifying demographic information with Pase about Pase and his girlfriend.

At 05:49, Sergeant Allar then asked:

*"Okay. Now, does this go back to him, him stealing your peaches?"*

At 05:57, Pase replied:

*"Um, yeah, we had them in the cabin. That's where we had our clothes  
and stuff at the cabin."*

At 07:34, Sergeant Allar asked:

*"...Who did you call about this first?"*

At 07:43, Pase said:

*"Uh, just 911."*

The interview then continued with information obtained from Rase that was not deemed to be useful or relevant to the investigation. The interview finally concluded with Sergeant Allar thanking Pase for speaking with him.
