APPROVAL—LEASE TO RESERVOIR LAND IN INDIAN LAKE, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO—GUY D. BAYLEY, SPRINGFIELD, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to one Guy D. Bayley of Springfield, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$60.00, payable in semi-annual installments of \$30.00 each, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for cottage site, boathouse and docklanding purposes, that portion of the State Reservoir property at Indian Lake, Ohio, described as follows:

A small island lying northwesterly from Tecumseh Island and southwesterly from Cranetown Island and being a part of Virginia Military Survey No. 12276, Stokes Township, Logan County, Ohio, known as "Turkey Foot Island."

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner, acting on behalf of the State of Ohio, and by Guy D. Bayley, the lessee therein named. Upon examination of the provisions of this lease and the conditions and restrictions therein contained, I find the same to be in conformity with the provisions of section 471 and of other sections of the General Code relating to leases of this kind.

I am, accordingly, approving this lease, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
