Narrative:

On Monday, April 12, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Russell (SA Russell) interviewed Charles Murray (Murray), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on Monday, April 12, 2021. The interview took place at Mt. Carmel St. Ann's Hospital, 500 S. Cleveland Ave., Westerville, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

Murray advised that he is a registered nurse employed at Mt. Carmel St. Ann's Hospital. He was with a patient in emergency room (ER) room #1 and heard an altercation, loud voices, and yelling coming from down the hall. He then heard what he believed to be three gunshots, so he sprinted out the EMS doors, past the parking area, and went down the external stairs, then called 911. He stayed on the phone with dispatch until Columbus Police Officers arrived on scene and then heard more shots. Upon hearing the additional shots, he moved further away around the corner of the building and was advising people to leave the area. Murray advised that was his total involvement and had no further pertinent information of the incident.
