EASEMENTS — TO STATE, SEVERAL PROPERTY OWNERS,
LAND, VERNON AND WASHINGTON TOWNSHIPS, CLIN-
TON COUNTY, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Vernon and Washington Townships, Clinton County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said townships and county.
