**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, January 16, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb) received an Ohio BCI Cyber Crimes Unit report for item(s) of evidence submitted on January 10, 2024 for scientific analysis. The report was authored by Cyber Special Agent Joseph Wilhelm and was dated January 10, 2024. The items relevant to this report which had previously been submitted were as follows:

1. 001 – Mobile Phone – Black Motorola One 5G ACE XT2113–5 (Donna Gullett’s phone)
2. 002 – Mobile Phone – Black Blu Blu View B131DL ([REDACTED] phone)

SA Holcomb reviewed the cyber report and the Cellebrite extraction and noted the following:

**001 – Mobile Phone – Black Motorola One (Donna Gullett)**

SA Holcomb reviewed Facebook messages on January 8, 2024. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated how she wasn’t sure she wanted to be with her boyfriend, Brandon Thibodeaux (Thibodeaux), and wanted Gullett and Skylar Corbin (Corbin) to come and pick her up.

On January 8, 2024, Gullett reached out to Corbin and stated that [REDACTED] wanted him to come help her move her belongings from her boyfriend’s place. Corbin stated that he was a changed man and had a job orientation later in the week.

**002 – Mobile Phone – Black Blu Blue View ([REDACTED])**

On November 2, 2023, [REDACTED] messaged Bradley Thibodeaux:

*"Are you ok? I see your post and I feel the same. Sky up and left after 10 fuckin years and it wasn't a month he was gone that he's in another relationship. Even trying to kill me and all. In the middle of losing another child bc of him. He acts like he didn't have it made with me. I fight daily to even wanna live. It hurts so I feel ya."*

On December 23, 2023, [REDACTED] sent the following message to Corbin:

*"Your getting mad but look how you did me and then ask me about birth control bc of some bitch but didn't believe you beat our child out of me"*

On December 24, 2023, Corbin sent the following message to [REDACTED]

*"If you don't get in the car I'm just gonna start beating windows out"*

On December 26, 2023, Corbin sent the following message to [REDACTED]

*"Well I'm just going to tell you something right now if you ever disrespect anyone else I'm friends with I'm not going to put my hands on you I'm just going to beat the living goddamn hell out of your man for you being wreckless and when I'm done with beating his teeth out I'm gonna be a straight smartass dick and look at you and smile as I walk away and I'm going to taunt you by not blocking you that way you are going to be able to see what you lost because you and I are never gonna get along you are so close to being hated more than anything I promise you on everything I stand for ill fuckin be that piece of shit really you should thank her for being able to get through my head and getting me to promise I won't hit another woman again because I really have a strong desire to beat your eye lids shut for the disrespectful shit you said about someone who is not even here to defend herself that's what a bitch ass person that is really just scared to death and won't bust a grape in Welch's backyard but I really like got adult stuff to do"*

**Summary:**

On 01/10/2024, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation's (BCI) Cyber Crimes Unit (CCU) was requested by the BCI Special Investigations Unit (SIU) to assist in the investigation of an Officer Involved Critical Incident. The BCI SIU submitted two cell phones believed to contain information relevant to their investigation and requested the devices' data be forensically extracted pursuant to written consent from the respective device's owner.

**Submitted Items:**

001 – Mobile Phone – Black Motorola One 5G Ace XT2113-5

002 – Mobile Phone – Black Blu Blu View 2 B131DL

**Details:**

**001:**

The cell phone was submitted powered on with the SIM card inserted. The phone was placed in Airplane mode to prevent communication on the cellular network upon receipt of the device into CCU. The cell phone did not have a passcode. The cell phone was connected to Cellebrite and a full file system extraction was performed. The extraction was processed with Cellebrite Physical Analyzer.

The cell phone was running the Android version 11 operating system. The phone had the serial number ZF6526RXXK, the International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) 354959220788664, and the Mobile Station International Subscriber Directory Number (MSISDN) [REDACTED]. The name of the phone was "motorola one 5g ace". The Google account associated with the device was [REDACTED].

**002:**

The cell phone was submitted powered on with the SIM card inserted. The phone was placed in Airplane mode to prevent communication on the cellular network upon receipt of the device

into CCU. The passcode provided by the case investigators was used to unlock the phone. The cell phone was connected to Cellebrite and a full file system extraction was performed. The extraction was processed with Cellebrite Physical Analyzer.

The cell phone was running the Android version 11 operating system. The phone had the serial number 1050339023107538, the International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) 35649988568884, and the Mobile Station International Subscriber Directory Number (MSISDN) [REDACTED]. The name of the phone was "B131DL". The Google account associated with the device was "[REDACTED]" .

#### **Conclusions:**

Data was extracted from the cell phones and provided to case investigators.

The "Cellebrite Reports" folder contains the Cellebrite Reader Reports of the device during the examination.

The folder "001" contains the Cellebrite Reader program and the report package of the data that was extracted from device 001, and the folder "002" contains the Cellebrite Reader program and the report package of the data that was extracted from device 002. Double-click "CellebriteReader.exe" to open the application. Allow a few seconds for the data to begin loading indicated by a green status bar in the bottom right corner. If the parsed data is not loaded automatically, click "Open" from the File menu, browse to the appropriate folder, and choose the ".ufdr" file to view the data that was processed from the device.

NOTE: In Cellebrite Reader, some entries may be hidden based on the program's default behavior. Go to Tools -> Settings -> General Settings -> "Duplicate Rules" and choose either "Show group of similar items" or "Show all items." Also go to Tools -> Settings -> Timeline and select all of the data desired in the Timeline view.
