**Narrative:**

On December 28, 2023, SA Call met with Gallia County Coroner, Dr. Dan Whitely (Dr. Whitely), at his office in Gallia County in order to obtain the coroner's office report (autopsy) of Roger Meade (Meade). Dr. Whitely also provided SA Call with the toxicology results and completed death certificate for Meade.

The coroner's report indicates the autopsy was completed at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office by Deputy Coroner Dr. Bradley Lachey, M.D., Forensic Pathologist and Deputy Coroner Dr. Susan Brown, D.O., Forensic Pathologist. [REDACTED]
