Narrative:

On April 29, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Jim Mulford (SA Mulford) and Andrew Russell (SA Russell) served subpoenas to Mount Carmel East Hospital and Madison Township Fire Department for medical records pertaining to Ma'Khia Bryant (Bryant).

The medical records were requested in response to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) incident that took place on April 20, 2021, involving the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) and Bryant.

The records provided to BCI were saved electronically within the case file and are attached to this report. Please review those records for specific details.

On May 5, 2021, SA Mulford reviewed the medical records. The records indicate, "IEAPR201705 is a 120 Years Unknown who presents as a category 1 trauma. The patient presents with multiple gunshot wounds including 1 to the back. The patient was pulseless on scene. Per EMS was a very hostile environment so she was picked up and brought immediately to emergency department. She did have epinephrine given in route and had 10 established. LMA was placed. Patient was asystolic for them and continued to be in asystole."

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

Narrative
C Unknown age female c/c multiple gunshot wounds.
H Female found at end of the driveway involved in a shooting. Ems was initiated with comments that said "police-involved shooting".
A Upon arrival female lying at end of a driveway with an officer performing CPR. Scene was very chaotic and people were yelling from all around us. Female was not breathing and pt needed to be removed from the environment immediately.
R Pt lifted to the cot and loaded quickly to perform suction and continue CPR. Pt pulseless and still not breathing at this time. Pupils were dilated. CPR continued and put on Lucas device. Suction of the airway was also being performed at this time to clear blood and vomit. IGEL airway inserted and bag valve mask used to perform ventilations. Capnography attached and reading 15. IO access was made and Epi was given. Pt reading Asystole on the cardiac monitor. Pulse and rhythm check every 2 minutes with no changes. Epi was also given 2 more times. During trauma assessment, pt had gunshot wounds on R shoulder two of them, right flank, and right thigh.
T Pt transported to MCE ER emergency status and care given to trauma staff and ER nurse.
Ems Coordinator opened run up and added life pack information from monitor 04/26/2021 Also had to update IO time due to putting in wrong time.
