Narrative:

On April 1, 2022, at approximately 1800 hours, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by Youngstown Police Department to conduct an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding an officer-involved shooting which occurred in the area of 914 Salt Spring Road, Youngstown, Ohio. BCI Special Agent (SA) Al Bansky (Bansky) responded to assist, arriving at approximately 1900 hours. Also responding from BCI Special Investigations Unit were Special Agents Eric Lehnhart, Jack Shea, John Tingley and Special Agent Supervisor, David Posten. Additionally, the BCI Crime Scene Unit was requested to process the scene by documenting and collecting pertinent evidence.

The shooting incident involved a subject, James John Sheets (Sheets), and members of the Struthers Police Department. The incident resulted in the death of Sheets. Mahoning County Coroner's Investigator Kelsey Simon was on scene, and next of kin and the Mahoning County Prosecutor was notified by SA Bansky.
