to this issue was approved by this office in an opinion rendered to your board under date of May 21, 1934, being Opinion No. 2701.

It is accordingly my opinion that these bonds constitute valid and legal obligations of said city.

APPROVAL—EASEMENT No. 1735, CONVEYANCE TO STATE OF OHIO, TRACT OF LAND IN PULASKI AND SPRING-FIELD TOWNSHIPS, WILLIAMS COUNTY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.
