SUMMARY

On November 14, 2024, pursuant to a search warrant, BCI Special Agent Tiffany Najmulski submitted the below listed items for an **Officer Involved Critical Incident**. The case investigator has requested extraction and parsing of the submitted devices.

DETAILS

Submitted Item(s):

BCI CCU Item 1 (CSU# 28) – Mobile Phone – Rose Gold Apple iPhone iPhone Xs Max A1921
BCI CCU Item 2 (CSU #7) – Mobile Phone – Black Samsung Galaxy Galaxy S9 Sm-G960U1

November 15 – 20, 2024

BCI evidence Item #1 was an Apple iPhone XS Max, model A1921. The device was locked with an unknown 4-digit passcode. The passcode for the device was determined to be "██████". The device was connected to a forensic tool capable of obtaining a file system extraction from the device.

The extraction was loaded into Cellebrite Physical Analyzer, a software package that converts the data to an easily readable format, where a report containing the full extractable contents of the phone can be exported. A Cellebrite Reader report was created from the extraction for review by the investigator.

BCI evidence Item #2 was a Samsung Galaxy S9 phone, model SM-G960U1. The device was locked with an unknown 4-digit passcode. The device was connected to a forensic tool capable of determining the passcode on the device. The passcode for the device was determined to be "██████". The device was connected to a forensic tool capable of obtaining a file system extraction from the device.

The extraction was loaded into Cellebrite Physical Analyzer. A Cellebrite Reader report was created from the extraction for review by the investigator.

FINDINGS

On the included memory card is Cellebrite Reader versions of the processed data from Items 1 and 2. Running the CellebriteReader.exe file will launch the software and load the case file.

Note: For best results copy the folder from the memory card to the local computer before opening.

A copy of the results will be retained with the BCI case file.

Items #1 and 2 were processed and the results are presented with this report.
