Narrative:

On Wednesday, November 12, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Ryan Emahiser obtained a search warrant from the Summit County Court of Common Pleas to execute a search of Brad Bailey's (Brad) Gray Apple iPhone 16 Pro (Evidence No. P00020-1044983). The iPhone and search warrant were provided to the Ohio BCI Cyber Crime Unit (CCU) on November 13, 2025, to perform and execute a physical extraction of the data on the iPhone. Brad's wife Sarah Bailey (Sarah) had previously provided SA Emahiser the passcode (██████████) to Brad's iPhone, that was successfully used by the CCU in unlocking the iPhone during extraction. The passcode is ██████████

An extraction and parsing report was authored by CCU Computer Forensic Specialist (CFS) Natasha Branam dated December 29, 2025, and is enclosed in this Matrix case named **2025-12-29: Extraction & Parsing of Item 3**. On December 29, 2025, CFS Branam also provided SA Emahiser copies of the extractions performed via Axon Evidence, located in Axon case 2025-3318 folder - Reference Item G - Brad Bailey Cell Phone Extraction. CFS Branam compiled a full extraction of all the data on the device named Attachment B, and a separate extraction for the dates October 11, 2025, through October 12, 2025, named Attachment A.

SA Emahiser and BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) Analyst Jessica Smith reviewed the cyber report and Analyst Smith compiled a separate report of the findings named **CIU Cell Phone Extraction Analysis Report 2025-3318**, which has been uploaded to this case and attached to this report for review. The following items were of importance found in the review of the iPhone extraction and are also detailed in Analyst Smith's analysis report.

- The report lists the iPhone's assigned phone number as (234) 926-0412. Through open-source searches and prior reports this phone number was used and given by Brad Bailey. The iPhone was also assigned Apple ID:

runitup1983@icloud.com. The owner named of the iPhone was also listed as Brad Bailey.

- The only listed location data found on the iPhone around the time of the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) was at the McDonalds located at 4291 Mahoning Ave NW, Warren, Ohio, on October 12, 2025, at 03:00 hours.
- Multiple phone calls on the date of the incident were made on the iPhone to Sarah following the domestic dispute incident presumably by Brad, including just before the OICI occurred.
- Based on a multitude of calls being made on the iPhone on October 12, 2025, following the domestic dispute incident and leading up to the OICI, it is presumed that Brad did not sleep following the domestic dispute incident and leading to the vehicle pursuit and OICI.
- On October 11, 2025, the day prior to the OICI, Brad had numerous text messages with Sarah regarding his intent to commit suicide, such as "***I think I'm gonna buy a toy gun paint it black and go run after a cop,***" and "***I'm serious. I think I'm just gonna kill myself.***" On the same date Sarah also texts Brad telling him, "***You're choosing drugs and that's what ruined your life.***" Several text messages by Brad to others also indicate that he was likely to have been taking pain pills, and possibly other illegally obtained narcotics.
- In the days leading up to the OICI, and the domestic dispute incident at the Bailey residence, it is apparent that Brad had a belief that Sarah was cheating on Brad. Following the domestic dispute incident involving Trumbull County Sheriff's Office Deputies, it is also apparent that Brad was in desperation and feared going back to prison if Sarah sought a protection order against Brad.

For a full understanding of the information obtained it is recommended that the reader review the CCU Cellebrite extraction report, and the CIU Cell Phone Extraction Analysis Report 2025-3318 compiled.
