In accordance with the provisions of Section 4785-175 of the General Code of Ohio, you have submitted for my examination a written petition signed by one hundred qualified electors of this state, proposing an amendment to the first three sentences (comprising the first paragraph) of Section 1 of Article II; and repealing Sections 2, 3, 7, 9, 11, 14, 23, 24, 25 and 31 of Article II; and repealing Sections 9 and 16 of Article III; and repealing Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Article XI of the Constitution of the State of Ohio, together with the summary of the same. Upon examination of said proposed amendments and supplemental sections and said summary thereof, I am of the opinion that said summary is a fair and truthful statement of said proposed amendments and supplemental sections and accordingly submit for the uses provided by law the following certification:
