A P P R O V A L — REVISED CONTRACT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH ACTING DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS, WITH VILLAGE OF WAUSEON, IMPROVEMENT STATE HIGHWAYS NOS. 296 AND 298, FULTON COUNTY, OHIO.

Dear Sir: You have submitted for my approval as to form and legality a revised contract in duplicate, by and between the Village of Wauseon and the State of Ohio, providing for the improvement of state highways numbers 296 and 298, section Wauseon (part) situated in the Village of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, said contract being in conformity with Section 1200, General Code. Attached thereto is a revised certificate of the village clerk of Wauseon, Ohio, certifying that the money required for the payment of the cost of said improvement to be borne by said village, is in the treasury to the credit of, or in the process of collection for the State and Village Road Improvement Fund and not appropriated for any other purpose or is being obtained by the sale of bonds of the Village, issued on account of said improvement, which bonds are sold and in process of delivery.

After careful examination of said revised contract, it is my opinion that the same is in proper legal form and constitutes a binding agreement by and between the State of Ohio and the Village of Wauseon for the purposes therein stated. I have, therefore, endorsed my approval as to form and legality upon said revised contract in duplicate and am returning the same herewith.
