Narrative:

On Monday, November 24, 2025, at 0830 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) met with Prosecutor April Grabman (Prosecutor Grabman) and Assistant Prosecutor Dawn Cantalamessa at the Ashtabula County Prosecutor's Office. The case file for this investigation had been digitally transmitted to the Ashtabula County Prosecutor's Office (ACPO) on Friday, November 21, 2025, by Special Agent Supervisor Charles Moran via Matrix Exchange and Axon Justice.

During the course of the meeting, Prosecutor Grabman requested that a presumptive field test be conducted on two bindles containing white powder located on Pegram's body. SA Lamping advised that the testing would be completed, documented, and forwarded to the Ashtabula County Prosecutor's Office for review. Additionally, SA Lamping informed Prosecutor Grabman that the autopsy report and BCI Laboratory analysis report would be forwarded to the ACPO after they were received and reviewed.

At this time, BCI is awaiting further direction from the prosecutor's office as to any additional follow-up investigation they may wish and any decisions regarding possible grand jury presentations or prosecutions related to the incident.
