Narrative:

On October 22, 2024, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by the Ravenna Police Department (RPD) to conduct an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred in the area of Portage Bike Trail near North Freedom Street, Ravenna, Ohio.

BCI Special Investigations Unit and BCI Crime Scene Unit agents responded to assist. The shooting incident involved a subject, Matthew Fries (Fries), and police officers from RPD. As a result of an interaction between Fries and witness Larry Burghy (Burghy) near the scene, Burghy was transported to University Hospital Portage Medical Center (UHPMC) for treatment of lacerations. RPD Officers were not believed to have any physical injuries but were transported to UHPMC as a standard protocol.

On October 22, 2024, at approximately 1230 hours, Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (Bynum) and SA Allison Fletcher (Fletcher) arrived at UHPMC. At approximately 1235 hours, SA Bynum and SA Fletcher met with RPD was asked if an exam room at the Emergency Department (ED). Was asked if she would like to give a statement, but at the advice of her FOP representative, she requested to speak later. At approximately 1305 hours, SA Bynum and SA Fletcher met with RPD Officer Matthew Meyers in an exam room at the ED. Officer Meyers was asked if he would like to give a statement, but on the advice of his FOP representative, he requested to speak later.

At approximately 1310 hours, SA Bynum and SA Fletcher met with RPD Officer Joshua Twigg in an exam room at the ED. Officer Twigg was asked if he would like to give a statement, but on the advice of his FOP representative, he requested to speak later.

At approximately 1315 hours, SA Bynum and SA Fletcher met with witness Larry Burghy in an exam room at the ED. Burghy was asked if he would like to give a statement about the incident and he stated he would. Burghy's statement is in the report labeled "2024-12-02: Witness Interview Larry Burghy". Burghy consented both verbally and on a written consent form that is attached for the collection of his DNA profile as a standard for comparison.
