Narrative:

On Wednesday, March 29, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) reviewed the personnel, training, and Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) Officer Records for Vienna Township Police Department (VTPD) Officer (Ofc.) [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]). SA Tingley reviewed the provided documentation and noted the following:

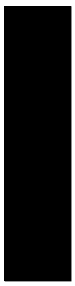



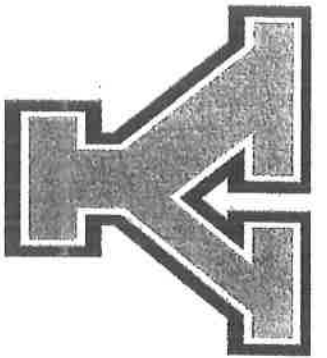
