### Narrative:

On Wednesday, March 29, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) reviewed the personnel, training, and Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) Officer Records for Vienna Township Police Department (VTPD) Officer (Ofc.) SA Tingley reviewed the provided documentation and noted the following:

### Personnel File

Ofc. was hired by the VTPD as a full-time officer on December 12, 2021.







Incomplete or improper appointment documents will not be processed and will be returned for correction.

If you have already been appointed with an agency and your notice of appointment has been sent to OPOTC, your certificate will be issued upon review of your test results by OPOTC staff.
