Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 31, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that Michael Decker (Decker) possessed during the incident on March 30, 2026. The report provided details about the semi-automatic 9mm Sig Sauer, model P229, serial number 55E045578, including that it was purchased by [REDACTED]

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. According to the report, the weapon was not stolen.
