DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works, for the Board of Trustees of the Ohio State University, and The Samuel A. Esswein Heating & Plumbing Company, of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of Plumbing Contract, for New Chemistry Building, Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio, and calls for an expenditure of seventeen thousand nine hundred dollars (\$17,900.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. I am informed that the plumbing work involved in the above contract is to be furnished in connection with the equipment of the new chemistry building and that no part of said work is to be incorporated into and become a part of the building itself. If that be true, the consent of the Controlling Board to the expenditure of the money for this contract is not required under the provisions
