APPROVAL—CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND THE E. KELLER COMPANY OF WILLIAMSPORT, PENNSYLVANIA FOR FURNISHING THE BOILER AND STOKER AT DAYTON STATE HOSPITAL, DAYTON. OHIO.

DEAR MADAM: You have submitted for my approval a contract by and between the State of Ohio, acting by Margaret M. Allman, Director, Department of Public Welfare, and E. Keller Company of Williamsport, Pa., for the furnishing of a boiler and stoker for the Dayton State Hospital, Dayton, Ohio, which contract calls for a total expenditure of twenty-nine thousand nine hundred seventy-five dollars (\$29,975.00).

You have also submitted a letter showing the approval by the Controlling Board of Ohio, a copy of a letter to the Auditor of State showing the necessary papers to be on file with that office, the estimate of cost, notice to bidders, proof of publication, tabulation of bids, form of proposal, the contract bond signed by the United States Guarantee Company, its power of attorney for its signer, and its certificate of compliance with the laws of Ohio relating to surety companies, a certificate of the Secretary of State showing the compliance by the contractor with the foreign corporation laws of Ohio, certificate of the Industrial Commission showing compliance by the contractor with the workmen's compensation law of Ohio, encumbrance estimate No. 33, and five copies of the contract.

Finding said contract and bond in proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with all papers submitted in this connection.
