Narrative:

On Thursday, July 06, 2023 at approximately 1837 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Jon Scale (SA Scale) attempted to interview the male driver and female passenger in a black Chevrolet Cobalt, relative to the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) officer-involved shooting (OIS) which took place earlier that day on at I-70 East near Mound Street in Columbus, OH. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by these individuals.

SA Scale approached the black Chevy Cobalt (Indiana plate ETS191) and attempted to interview the driver and passenger. The male driver refused to provide his name and stated that he did not witness anything regarding the OIS. The female passenger said that her name was Lauralye Lee. She said that she did not know what had happened and did not witness anything regarding the OIS.
