	On October 22, 2023, at approximately 1045 hours, I was contacted by the Gallia County 911 Center. I was informed that deputies from the Gallia County Sheriff's Office had been involved in a shooting at a location in Huntington Township.						
	I was later contacted by Sheriff Matt Champlin and he requested for me to generate an affidavit for a search warrant for the property where the incident occurred. After speaking with Lt. Chris Gruber, I learned that the incident occurred at a camper in Huntington Township but the land that they camper was occupying did not have an exact mailing address. Through investigative efforts, I learned that the camper was possibly on two different parcels. Those parcels were identified as 01500140301 & 01500140501 and is owned by Valerie Braden.						
I generated an affidavit for search warrant for parcel numbers 01500140301 & 01500140501 on October 22, 2023. The said warrant was reviewed and granted by Judge Eric Mulford through Gallipolis Municipal Court on October 22, 2023, at approximately 1304 hours.							
After receiving the said warrant, I responded to the scene and assisted deputies and agents from the Ohio Attorney General Office's Bureau of Criminal Investigation with scene containment.							
All law enforcement personnel cleared the scene on October 22, 2023, at approximately 1938 hours.

October 22, 2023

1042 hrs.

I was in church and I received a phone call from 911 dispatch regarding an officer involved shooting on SR160/Bull Run area. I advised that I would be enroute.

1051 hrs.

I departed my residence enroute to the scene.

1100 hrs.

I arrived at the scene and made contact with Sgt. Haislop of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Deputy [REDACTED] and Deputy [REDACTED] who were standing at the rear of Deputy [REDACTED]'s Patrol Vehicle. I checked on their status and Deputy [REDACTED] proceeded into the camper to relieve Deputy [REDACTED] who was providing medical attention to Mr. Meade along with Trooper Jim Trelka.

Deputy [REDACTED] stepped out and asked if I would check him over for gunshot wounds, as he stated that he had not had time to check himself over to see if he was hit. I proceeded to check him for injuries, without finding any. I then stepped into the camper and I took over giving chest compressions from Tpr. Trelka who needed a break. Mr. Meade was laying on the floor of the camper on his back and he was handcuffed. Mr. Meade appeared to have a gunshot wound to the center of his upper chest and a second gunshot wound to his left shoulder. A chest seal had been applied to the wound located on his chest. Deputy [REDACTED] and I continued to provide CPR and oxygen to Mr. Peck until the EMS Personnel arrived and took over.

Deputy [REDACTED] had collected Deputy [REDACTED]'s handgun prior to my arrival and he provided Deputy [REDACTED] with his handgun. I then provided Deputy [REDACTED] with my handgun and I collected Deputy [REDACTED] handgun from Deputy [REDACTED] who had placed the handgun in a paper evidence bag.

I made contact with Erin McMillin who was a female who was in the camper at the time of the shooting. She was handcuffed and placed in the rear of Deputy [REDACTED]'s patrol vehicle as the deputies entered the camper to provide aide to Mr. Meade. I gathered her information and gave it to dispatch. I inquired from the three deputies if the female was involved in the shooting and if she had been patted down for weapons. They advised she was not involved and after I received word from dispatch that she did not have an active warrants for her arrest, I asked her to step out of the vehicle and I patted her down for weapons, with Deputy [REDACTED] as a witness and I removed her handcuffs. I advised her that was not under arrest but we would like to get a statement from her about the incident once BCI arrived. She agreed and had a seat back in the patrol vehicle. After she sat down, I asked her if she was okay and if she need EMS to look at her; she advised that she was fine. Ms. McMillin stated that she had no idea why Roger shot at the deputies. She stated that he was up all night long and she did not think he slept at all. I asked her if she was living there and she stated no, she was just visiting and she had stayed the night. She stated that Roger was a boyfriend from the past but they were not currently involved with each other. She stated that Roger said he was going to shoot the person who was knocking at his door. Ms. McMillin kept saying, "I don't understand why he shot at them". I ended my conversation with her and I did not speak to her after that.

At that time, I observed Lt. Jason Roe, Post Commander of the Gallia-Meigs Patrol Post. I made contact with Lt. Roe and I asked him if he and a few of his troopers could check the surrounding residences to make sure that they were okay and that no one was struck with any gunfire. A short time later, Lt. Roe advised that everyone they spoke to was fine.

Then gathered Deputies [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and I asked each of them to give me a brief statement of what happened. Each of them explained where they were located when Mr. Meade opened the door and shot at Deputy [REDACTED] and how they secured the female and began providing medical treatment to Mr. Meade.

Sheriff Champlin arrived on scene and I briefed him on what I had learned. I placed a call to FOP Keith Washburn to advise him of the incident and I provided him with the phone numbers of the deputies that were involved.

I remained on at the location for most of the day providing scene security until the BCI Agents arrived. I then relayed some of the vehicles at the scene back to our office and some officers back to the scene to get their vehicles.

On October 22, 2023, I was contacted by Gallia County 911 Communications Center Operator Richard "Eugene" Valentine via radio call on the Gallipolis Police radio frequency and advised that Deputies had been involved in a deputy-involved shooting incident. I gathered my equipment and departed from the Gallia County Sheriff's Office in my agency-issued patrol vehicle. I responded with emergency equipment activated while proceeding northbound on State Route 160. I came upon Gallia County Emergency Medical Services who arrived on the scene simultaneously.

Upon arrival, I located Deputy [REDACTED] seated on the rear bumper of Deputy [REDACTED] agency issued Chevrolet Tahoe. Deputy [REDACTED] was accompanied by Trooper Jim Trelka of the Ohio State Highway Patrol Gallia-Meigs Post. Deputy [REDACTED] was visually shaking and upset, and I attempted to converse with him to calm him. I then made contact with Deputy [REDACTED] who was in the proximity of his patrol vehicle. Deputy [REDACTED] indicated that there was a female in the rear of his patrol vehicle, who was thereafter identified as Erin McMillen. Deputy [REDACTED] assured me that he was okay. I inquired if he had his cellular telephone with him to which he answered in the affirmative. I suggested that he contact his spouse to notify her that he was safe. I then met with Deputy [REDACTED], who was likewise near Deputy [REDACTED]'s patrol vehicle. I confirmed with Hill that he was not injured and likewise suggested that he contact his spouse to notify he/she/they that he was safe.

I met with responding troopers and requested that they establish a crime scene log and secure the scene with crime scene tape.

Upon Gallia County Emergency Medical Services Paramedics checking the involved subject and declaring him deceased, Chief Deputy Johnson joined the involved Deputies and me near the rear of Deputy [REDACTED]'s patrol vehicle. Deputy Johnson turned over custody of Deputy [REDACTED] duty weapon to me, which was placed into a brown paper evidence bag upon my receipt.

Sheriff Champlin arrived on the scene and advised that he had spoken with the responding Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation Crime Scene and Special Investigation Units, who authorized the involved Deputies to depart from the scene and return to the Gallia County Sheriff's Office.

Before the involved Deputy departed from the scene, I obtained a series of photographs of each involved Deputy in their uniforms as a fair and accurate depiction of the deputy duty uniforms at the time of the deputy-involved shooting.

I cleared the scene and escorted the BCI SIU investigator to the Gallia County Sheriff's Office where I allowed him access to the Sheriff's Office to meet with the involved deputies.

Adam Holcomb, AFFIANT, States these facts and circumstances:

Probable cause for this request is as follows:

The Gallia County Sheriff's Office takes a pro-active approach to the investigation of major crimes within Gallia County. The Gallia County Sheriff's Office is continually investigating major crimes within the community and receives information from various sources, including individuals whom officers come into






