The above purchase of bonds appears to be part of an issue of bonds of the above city dated July 1, 1925. The transcript relative to this issue was approved by this office in an opinion rendered to the Teachers Retirement System under date of June 8, 1934, being Opinion No. 2804.

It is accordingly my opinion that these bonds constitute valid and legal obligations of said city.
