Narrative:

On Monday, April 12, 2021, at approximately 1720 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Jim Mulford (SA Mulford) interviewed Alexa Haught (Haught) in response to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred earlier this date at Mount Carmel St. Ann's Hospital in Westerville, OH. An altercation occurred between Miles Jackson (Jackson) and officers from the Columbus Division of Police, Westerville Police, and St. Ann's Security Department. Jackson died as a result of gunshot wounds from this incident. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

This interview was audio recorded, and a copy of the recording was saved electronically within the case file. Please refer to the recording for specific quotes. The following is a summation of the interview.

Haught explained she is a paramedic at St. Ann's and has been for the last two and a half years. She worked from 0900 hours to 1900 hours this date. She had no direct contact with Jackson during her shift. Throughout the day she did see Jackson in his room with officers standing nearby in the hallway. Laura Webb was his assigned nurse.

Prior to the incident, she was with another patient in room #98 when she heard yelling coming from emergency room #9. Haught then heard gunshots and a male voice yelling "He's got a gun." She shut the door to the room and hid quietly with the patient. A short time later she heard more yelling and then multiple (30) gunshots.

Haught did not witness any of the incident, and had no further information.
