Dear Sir: You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works, Carl G. Wahl, Director, and The Weiss Heating & Plumbing Company of Cleveland, Ohio, for a project known as Revised September 2, 1937 (Plumbing) North and South Porches Main Building Cleveland State Hospital, Cleveland, Ohio, which contract calls for the total expenditure of two thousand four hundred and eighty dollars (\$2,480.00).
