APPROVAL—LEASE OF RESERVOIR LANDS EXECUTED BY
THE STATE OF OHIO TO WALTER B. HUBER OF AKRON,
OHIO.

DEAR SIR: I am in receipt of a communication from the chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, requesting my approval on a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the State of Ohio through you as Conservation Commissioner to Walter B. Huber of Akron, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$36.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes only, that portion of the State Reservoir property located on the northwesterly shore of North Reservoir in Coventry Township, Summit County, Ohio, as described in said lease.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by you as Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
