On September 5, 2023, Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) sent Officer **Sector** s (Officer **Sector** body-worn camera footage to the Ohio Organized Crime Investigation Commission (OCIC) for video enhancement.

On September 27, 2023, agents received the enhanced version of Officer **s** body-worn camera footage.

SA Momchilov was provided a total of three video presentations:

SA Momchilov reviewed the enhanced video footage.

In reviewing the above footage, SA Momchilov focused on documenting audio waveform spikes that would be indicative of gunfire.

As Team Members are attempting to make entry into the house. A waveform spike is observed at approximately 01:46:22/23 into the footage. It is believed that this waveform spike is Randall Fife firing upon officers.

Approximately 01:47:22 into the footage, another waveform spike is observed. It is believed that this waveform spike is Team Member(s) returning fire. Based on Officer s position at this time, it is unknown which Team Member is discharging their weapon.





Approximately 01:59:10 into the footage, a waveform spike consistent with gunfire is observed.




Approximately 01:59:20 into the footage, a waveform spike consistent with gunfire is observed.
