APPROVAL, LEASE TO CANAL LAND IN FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE RIGHT TO OCCUPY AND USE FOR BOATHOUSE AND DOCKLANDING PURPOSES—EDITH EVANS.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes & Parks, submitting for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Edith Evans of Clinton, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years, and which calls for an annual rental of six dollars (\$6.00), there is leased and demised to the lessee therein named the right to occupy and use for boathouse and docklanding purposes the waterfront and state land in the rear thereof that lies immediately in front of Lots Nos. 86 and 87 in the First Addition to Turkeyfoot Park Allotment in the northeast quarter of section 12, Franklin Township, Summit County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by the lessee therein named. I further find upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained that the same are in conformity with section 471 and other sections of the General Code relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
