On June 14, 2021, at approximately 0256 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (SA Harasimchuk) was contacted by BCI Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Josh Durst (SAS Durst). SAS Durst requested that SA Harasimchuk assist BCI SA Justin Soroka (SA Soroka) in processing a scene of an officer involved critical incident (shooting) at 5714 South Park Boulevard, Parma, Cuyahoga County, Ohio 44134.

On June 17, 2021, at approximately 1030 hours, SA Harasimchuk was contacted by SA Soroka. SA Soroka requested that SA Harasimchuk further assist with this investigation by responding to the Parma Fire Department Station #1, located at 5625 Pearl Road, Parma, Cuyahoga County, Ohio 44129, to collect additional evidence. SA Soroka advised SA Harasimchuk that SA Soroka had just learned that members of the Southwest Enforcement Bureau (SEB) Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team had fired from inside of the SEB SWAT armored vehicle and that fired cartridge cases had been located inside of the vehicle.

On June 17, 2021, at approximately 1210 hours, SA Harasimchuk arrived at the above-mentioned location.

SA Harasimchuk photographed the SEB SWAT armored vehicle (Figure #1).

The SEB SWAT vehicle was searched. One Hornady 223 REM fired cartridge case (Scene #2, Item #1) and one Winchester 223 REM fired cartridge case (Scene #2, Item #2) were located in the rear portion of the vehicle (Figure #2).
